The Scouts' Book of Heroes (WW!) foreword by B-P: "What can we do to perpetuate the memory of those who ennobled by their splendid sacrifice the otherwise brutish work of battle? The Federación de Escultismo en España (ASDE) is the National Scout Organization within WOSM and consists of three member organizations. The ASDE was founded in 1912 by Teodoro Iradier y Herrero and Arturo Cuyás. In 1940, after the Spanish Civil War, the *Exploradores de España* were suspended by Franco's regime, but could continue their activities as *Asociación Nacional de Exploradores de España* (ANEDE, *National Association of Spanish Explorers*) with a semi-tolerated status. The organization was fully legalized in 1977 under the name *Asociación de Scouts de España* (*Spanish Scout Association*) during the reforms after Franco's death. In 1978, it formed the Federación de Escultismo en España with the Movimiento Scout Católico and the Federació Catalana d'Escoltisme i Guiatge and was readmitted to the World Organization of the Scout Movement the same year.

The Movimiento Scout Católico (MSC, Catholic Scout Movement) is a Roman Catholic Scouting organization in Spain, under the shelter of the Catholic Church.

The Federació Catalana d'Escoltisme i Guiatge (FCEG, Catalan Federation of Scouting and Guiding) is the federation of three Scout and Guide associations in Catalonia.



Thai Scouts Promotion Foundation formed the World Heritage Scout Troop to run important activities at the Ayutthaya World Heritage site located at the former capital of Thailand. The Scout Troop completed the training on Cultural World Heritage Sites by experts from the Fine Arts Department of Thailand on the history and preservation of this important place. The troop plans to plant ancient trees in 30 ancient temples, organize a Scout bicycle patrol to work with tourist police, and to help in the site's maintenance and cleanliness.
